# 23-11.12 Strategic Planning

Since the Commitment-to-Success Plan's adoption in June and the Plan of Action's presentation in October, we are currently on schedule. The Assistant Director General, Nancy L'Heureux, presented the tool that keeps track of the progress in our action plans as well as a report on the months of August through November. Going forward, the report would cover only the progress done in the last month, in between councils.

#### 23-11.13 New Business

a) Three-year Plan for the Destination of Immovables and Deeds of Establishment (deposit)

The draft Three-year Plan for the Destination of Immovables and Deeds of Establishment has been received for consultation purposes. The final document will be presented for adoption at the January 24, 2024, meeting of the Council of Commissioners.

b) Québec City School Calendar – Youth Sector 2024–2025 (adoption)

WHEREAS section 238 of the Education Act stipulates that every school board shall establish the school calendar of its schools, taking into account the provisions of the basic school regulation;

WHEREAS the teachers' collective agreement provides for a committee that is consulted on the school calendar;

WHEREAS the committee has met and has been consulted on and recommends the adoption of the proposed calendar for the 2024–2025 school year;

It was MOVED by A. Gosselin, SECONDED by I. O'Gallagher, and unanimously RESOLVED; THAT the Central Québec School Board accept the school calendar (Québec City—Youth Sector) for the 2024–2025 school year as presented.

# c) Amendment to the By-law regarding the day, time and place of regular meetings

WHEREAS section 162 of the Education Act indicates that the Council of Commissioners must adopt a by-law concerning the day, time and place of its regular meetings;

WHEREAS section 392 of the Education Act stipulates that public notice must be given before the adoption of a by-law;

It was MOVED by A. Gosselin, SECONDED by D. Eden, and unanimously RESOLVED; THAT the June 19, 2024, regular meeting of the Council of Commissioners that was to be held at 7 p.m. at the Board Office or online via the TEAMS platform be moved to June 12, 2024.

## d) Draft Proposal for the Division of the Electoral Map (adoption)

WHEREAS the Act Respecting School Elections requires that the territory of school boards be divided into electoral divisions according to the number of electors;

WHEREAS at the November 15, 2023, pre-session of the Council of Commissioners' meeting, the electoral map division proposal of the eleven electoral divisions was presented to the Council of Commissioners;

WHEREAS a public notice will be published giving electors 15 days to signify their disagreement with the proposal;

WHEREAS the Act Respecting School Elections requires school boards to adopt the final electoral divisions no later than December 31 of the year preceding the election;

It was MOVED by A. Gosselin, SECONDED by F. Pedneault, and unanimously RESOLVED; THAT in accordance with the Act Respecting School Elections, the Central Québec School Board adopt the draft proposal for the division of the Electoral Map separating its territory into eleven (11) electoral divisions as in presented; and

THAT a public notice will be published giving electors 15 days to signify their disagreement with the proposal; and

THAT the Council of Commissioners will need to adopt a final division proposal for the purposes of that election during the December 13, 2023, regular meeting.

e) <u>Delegation: Transport Advisory Committee Membership for Other School Boards</u>

WHEREAS Section 2 of the Regulation Respecting Student Transportation states that the advisory committee on student transportation of a board shall consist of (...) the Director General or the Assistant Director General of any school board for which the board organizes student transportation;

WHEREAS the Director General has many other important responsibilities and cannot attend the meetings in the school boards that provide all or part of the transportation services for our schools;

WHEREAS the Director General intends to delegate this responsibility;
