Expectations in the Classroom

- 1. All cell phones are to be left in their lockers or placed in the classroom pocket when entering a classroom.
- 2. The teacher has the mandate to decide when the cell phone is to be taken out of the pocket for pedagogical use only.
- 3. During pedagogical use, students may not record, videotape, or take pictures of the teacher or other students in the class, during class.
- 4. Earbuds will not be tolerated in class.
- 5. Students are not permitted to listen to their individual music during class time.
- 6. If used for pedagogical purposes, all social media platforms will not be tolerated. Phones must remain on "Do not Disturb."
- 7. If a student does not collaborate with classroom expectations, the cell phone will be confiscated by the teacher.
- 8. If the student still does not collaborate, the cell phone will be registered at the office and returned at 3:05 by a designated secretary.
- 9. Phones must stay in the classroom when a student is excused out of class in case of an emergency.
- 10. Administration reserves the right to make the necessary intervention and remove technology in a classroom if it is impeding on student success and well-being.
- 11. Teachers are expected to model these expectations.

A dedicated member of staff will be responsible for the tracking and the confiscation of cellular devices in the context of a student's failure to comply with the expectations and guidelines of this policy.
