Our program structure

Divided in two blocks: Hockey Profile and RSEQ teams

- HOCKEY PROFILE (2000\$*)
- Opened to everyone (limited spots)
- 4 practices by cycle of 10 days (2 practices a week)
- Practices are from 8h00 to 9h20 (may start at 8h15*)
- Transportation to school after the practice (9h50)
- Juniors (Sec. 1-2) = Day 2, 5, 7, & 9
- Seniors (Sec. 3-4-5) = Day 1, 4, 6 & 8
- Development of individual skills and individual tactics
- No minimum skills requirement
- About 65 practices and long-term athlete development sports at the end of the year


Our program structure

- RSEQ TEAMS (2200\$*)
- Opened to elite players in the program
- 1-2 practices after school extra practices per week
- Practices are from 15h45 to 17h00 (Mondays and/or Thursdays)
- 50 games a year in a provincial league (exhibition, tournaments, playoffs)
- One tournament outside of the province
- Off-ice trainings at the school weight room
- Transportation for after school practices and away games
 (1 hour away or more) and hotel for showcases
 - Physiotherapy service & concussions detection with SHRed
 - Access to your own stall in the Fighting Irish locker room
 - Academic follow-up and rewards for academic success
 - Theorical seminars, presentation and video sessions
 - Post High School opportunities and exposure

- Inclusive program for international athletes and female players








