TRANSPORTATION AT A 2nd ADDRESS

The Transport Department recognizes, for the organization of the routes, only one main address for each parent and a second complementary address (guardian, babysitter or other). If you need to give us a 2nd address, please fill out this form [here online](#) before July 10th, 2020, and send it by email to transport@cgsb.qc.ca.

This second address will be entered by the Transport Department in your child's file.



This 2nd address must first be validated by the School Transportation Department before being confirmed and accepted.

YOU ARE MOVING?

Communicate your new address directly to the secretary of your child's school or, fill out [this form](#), also available on our website, and send it directly by email to the school. The Transportation Department will be notified and will automatically process the changes.

DID YOU KNOW THAT?

For high school students, when public transportation (RTC) is available in your area, your child **must** use the RTC services to get to school. Yellow school buses only service areas where public transportation is not provided by the City.



RTC BUSES FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

To the parents of students entering Secondary 1 at the beginning of the 2020-2021 school year and living in the *arrondissements* de la Ville de Québec, L'Ancienne-Lorette or Saint-Augustin-de-Desmaures

To get to school, high school students living in the above-mentioned *arrondissements* and cities use Québec City's public transportation service provided by the *Réseau de transport de la Capitale* (RTC).

RTC = MEANS MORE FLEXIBILITY

As the RTC routes are continually being improved, the School Board can offer this service to a larger number of students year after year; RTC services are much more flexible and convenient than "yellow school buses". Indeed, by using the RTC, students spend less time travelling, since the RTC routes are shorter and faster than those of yellow school buses. In addition, travelling with the RTC allows more students to participate in the various after-school activities at the end of the day.

OPUS CARD WITH PHOTO

Contrary to previous years, please note that students are now responsible for obtaining their Opus Photo Card; the RTC no longer offers the photo-taking service directly at the school. To obtain the Opus card, or to renew it if it has expired, please contact the RTC directly at **418-627-2511** or visit www.rtcquebec.ca.

If your child has never taken public transportation to get to school, we suggest that you have him or her practice the route a few times during the summer holidays. Your child will be more comfortable knowing his or her RTC route before the first day of school.

Also, don't forget that in addition to using his Opus card to get to school, your child can use it at any time, including weekends, according to the RTC schedules.

REIMBURSEMENT OF MONTHLY PASSES

In January and July, a reimbursement equivalent to 70% of the cost of monthly passes purchased during the school year will be issued to parents who have completed the form [here](#). In order to take advantage of this reimbursement, simply make sure to fill out and return this form before October 15th, 2020, to the following address transport@cgsb.qc.ca.
