TRANSPORTATION 2nd ADDRESS

The Transport Department recognizes, for the organization of the routes, only one main address for each parent and a second complementary address (guardian, babysitter or other).

If you need to inform us of a 2nd address, please fill out the [form online](#) before **AUGUST 10th, 2022** and send it by email to transport@cqsbc.ca.



The 2nd address must be first validated by the School Transportation Department before being confirmed and accepted.



YOU ARE MOVING?!

Communicate your new address directly to the secretary of your child's school or, [fill out this form](#), (which is also available on our website), and send it directly by **email to the school**. The Transportation Department will be notified by the school and will automatically process the changes.



JOINT CUSTODY?!

Please make sure that BOTH addresses are up to date and confirmed with the school secretary.

If the address is part of the school territory and bus service is offered in your area both parents can benefit from school transportation.

DAYCARE VS. TRANSPORTATION

If a child is registered in a school daycare 5 days a week, for both morning and afternoon, the child **will not be eligible** to be assigned to a school bus. The child will not have occasional access to school transportation; ex: when parents are on holiday or sick at home etc. It will be the parent's responsibility to transport the child

If a child is registered in school day care 5 days a week in the afternoon only or mornings only, school transportation could be provided for the mornings or afternoon only (if places are available) and the address is part of the transport territory.

If a child is registered in a school daycare on a part time schedule (**3 days minimum**) eligibility to take school transportation for the 2 remaining days could be provided if places are available and the address is part of the transport territory. Note that only a fixed schedule will be permitted.



DID YOU KNOW THAT?

For high school students, when public transportation is available in your area, your child must use those services to get to school. Yellow school buses only service areas where public transportation is not provided by the city.
