# Description of the Arvida School Municipality Archival Group

Title: Arvida School Municipality Archival Group

Measurement Indicators: 6 conventional boxes, equivalent to 1.5 linear meter

#### **Biographical Notes and Administrative History:**

According to the website of the Ministry of Culture and Communications on the Noyau institutionnel d'Arvida (French website only), Arvida is an industrial town founded in 1927 by the Aluminium Company of Canada Ltd (ALCOA) whose initial purpose was to house its workers. The opening of the plant attracted many workers of different nationalities. Soon, the need to educate the children became apparent. Although most of the workers were French Canadians, dissident homeowners called for the establishment of School Trustees to provide English-language education for Protestant students. In the book of minutes of school trustees' meetings, we can consult the resolutions concerning the allocation of budgets and the issuance of bonds which were intended to finance the construction of the Arvida Intermediate School. This school is part of School District No. 1.

In 1962, the merger of school trustees in the Saguenay region, namely Arvida, Chicoutimi (including Chicoutimi Nord) and Kénogami (including Jonquière), led to the creation of the Protestant School Municipality of Saguenay Valley. Subsequently, several mergers followed at different times: Saguenay "P" School Board, Eastern Québec Regional School Board (EQRSB) and Central Québec School Board (CQSB).

## **Localisation:**

At the time, civic numbers had not yet been assigned to the buildings; some streets were not even named. However, according to the website of the Ministry of Culture and Communications on the Noyau institutionnel d'Arvida (French website only), it can be stated that the location of the first school was located at latitude 48°26'4.0" and longitude -71°11'1.0". These coordinates correspond to the following historical addresses in the municipal district of Jonquière, Saguenay, Quebec where Riverside Regional Elementary School is housed:

- Joule Street;
- 868 Joule Street; and
- 1750 Joule Street.

# **Conservation History:**

The documents, originating from the Saguenay region, are stored in a vault under controlled environmental conditions at the Central Québec School Board's Document Management Centre located at the Eastern Québec Learning Centre in Québec City.

## **Scope and Content:**

The documents testify to the documentary management of the school municipality of Arvida. The evolution of teaching activities, the reflection of the linguistic and cultural situation as well as administrative activities are represented by the archival group.

#### **Support:**

All documents in the series are in paper support. No objects (trophies, flags, etc.), graduation albums or student photos can be found. However, some plans are included in the Administrative and Property Resource series.

#### **Preservation State:**

Several documents are rendered fragile, especially documents that have been folded and unfolded such as plans and press clippings. Pins, paper clips and nails were removed to limit rust damage.

#### **Language of the Documents:**

Most of the documents are in English; some documents are bilingual, English and French. Some documents have been translated into French.
