**SCHOOL ELECTIONS NOVEMBER 2024
DRAFT PROPOSAL FOR THE DIVISION OF
THE ELECTORAL MAP**

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of Commissioners of the Central Québec School Board has adopted the proposed division of the territory of the school board into electoral divisions for the school elections to be held on Sunday, November 3, 2024. Anyone wishing to consult the draft division of the territory, including a map, may do so at the administrative center located at 2046, chemin St. Louis, Québec, between 8:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. and 1:30 p.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, until November 1st, 2024.

Any elector has the right to make known in writing to the Director General of the school board, at the above-mentioned address, his or her opposition to the division proposal within 15 days of the publication of this notice. In the event that one hundred or more persons express their opposition, the school board will be obliged to hold a public meeting for the purpose of hearing the persons present on the proposed division into electoral divisions.

Notice to the Reader

Electoral district boundaries have been described in a clockwise direction. The use of the words street, avenue, boulevard, road and river implies their median line, unless otherwise indicated. The use of the rear line of a thoroughfare means that the boundary of the electoral district passes to the rear of the sites whose addresses front on the thoroughfare mentioned. The side of the road is indicated by a cardinal point. All administrative boundaries used in this description are those existing on November 15, 2023.

Ward #1 (1449 electors)

Composed of the regional county municipalities of La Côte-de-Beaupré and L'Île-d'Orléans. Composed of the City of Sainte-Brigitte-de-Laval. Also composed of the part of the City of Québec bounded as follows: from a point

situated at the junction of the hydroelectric line and the eastern municipal boundary, this boundary, the Saint-Charles River, Robert-Bourassa Autoroute, boulevard Bastien, boulevard Louis-XIV, the Laurentian Autoroute, Jean-Talon West boulevard, the line behind rue du Périgord (west and north-west side), boulevard Henri-Bourassa, rue des Cyprès, the boulevard du Loiret and the hydroelectric line to the starting point.

Ward #2 (1181 electors)

Composed of the Parish of Notre-Dame-des-Anges. Also composed of the part of the City of Québec bounded as follows: from a point situated at the junction of the southern municipal boundary and the continuation of Louis-Francoeur Street, this continuation, the line behind the properties facing this street on the west side, chemin Sainte-Foy, Versant-Nord boulevard, Duplessis Autoroute, Félix-Leclerc Autoroute, Charest Autoroute, Robert-Bourassa Autoroute, the Saint-Charles River, the municipal boundary to the starting point.

Ward #3 (1460 electors)

Composed of the City of Ancienne-Lorette and the Native Reserve of Wendake. Also composed of the part of the City of Québec bounded as follows: from a point situated at the junction of the northern municipal boundary and route de la Bravoure, this road, the hydroelectric line north of rue de la Rivière-Nelson, the Saint-Charles River, Jacques-Bédard street, chemin de la Sagamité, Laurentian Autoroute, boulevard Louis-XIV, boulevard Bastien, Robert-Bourassa Autoroute, Charest Autoroute, Félix-Leclerc Autoroute, Canadian National Railway, Wilfrid-Hamel boulevard, rang Saint-Ange and the municipal boundary to the starting point.

Ward #4 (1423 electors)

Composed of: Fossambault-sur-le-Lac, Lac-Beauport, Lac-Delage, Lac-Saint-Joseph, Saint-Gabriel-de-Valcartier, Shannon and Stoneham-and-Tewkesbury. Also composed of the city of Sainte-Catherine-de-la-Jacques-Cartier bounded as follows: from a point situated at the junction of the Jacques-Cartier River and the western municipal boundary, this western boundary, north and east, the line behind route Montcalm (north-west side), the route de Fossambault and the Jacques-Cartier

River to the starting point. Also composed of the part of the City of Québec bounded as follows: from a point situated at the junction of the eastern municipal boundary and the hydroelectric line, this hydroelectric line, boulevard du Loiret, rue des Cyprès, boulevard Henri-Bourassa, Jean-Talon West boulevard, Laurentian Autoroute, chemin de la Sagamité, Jacques-Bédard street, Saint-Charles River, the hydroelectric line north of rue de la Rivière-Nelson, Henri-IV Autoroute, the municipal boundary to the starting point.

Ward #5 (1473 electors)

Composed of the regional county municipalities of Portneuf (excluding the unorganized territories of Lac-Blanc, Lac-Lapeyrère and Linton) and Les Chenaux (excluding the Parish of Notre-Dame-du-Mont-Carmel). Also composed of the municipalities: Lac-aux-Sables, Notre-Dame-de-Montauban, Saint-Adelphe, Saint-Augustin-de-Desmaures, Saint-Séverin and Sainte-Thècle. Composed of the part of the City of Québec bounded as follows: from a point situated at the junction autoroute Félix-Leclerc and autoroute Duplessis, this road, Versant-Nord boulevard, chemin Sainte-Foy, the line behind the properties facing Louis-Francoeur street on the west side, the continuation of this street, the municipal boundary, rang Saint-Ange, boulevard Wilfrid-Hamel, the rail row track Chemins de fer Canadien National and autoroute Félix-Leclerc to the starting point. Also composed of the city of Sainte-Catherine-de-la-Jacques-Cartier bounded as follows: from a point situated at the junction of the western municipal boundary and the Jacques-Cartier River, this river, the route de Fossambault, the line behind route Montcalm (north-west side) and the eastern municipal boundary, south and west to the starting point. Also includes the City of Trois-Rivières situated to the east of the Saint-Maurice River.

Ward #6 (1416 electors)

Composed of the regional county municipalities of L'Islet, Montmagny, Bellechasse and Les Etchemins (excluding the municipalities of Saint-Zacharie and Sainte-Aurélié). Also composed of the municipalities of: Frampton, Lévis, Saint-Isidore, Saint-Lambert-de-Lauzon, Saint-Odilon-de-Cranbourne, Sainte-Hénédine, Sainte-Marguerite, Sainte-Marie, Sainte-Marguerite and Scott.

Ward #7 (1171 electors)

Composed of the regional county municipalities of Nicolet-Yamaska, Bécancour, Lotbinière, L'Érable, Les Appalaches, Beauce-Sartigan and Robert-Cliche (excluding the Parish of Saint-Odilon-de-Cranbourne). Also composed of the municipalities of: Saint-Bernard, Saint-Elzéar, Saint-Zacharie, Sainte-Aurélié and Vallée-Jonction. Also includes the part of the City of Victoriaville and the part of the Municipality of Yamaska that is within the limits of the school board.

Ward #8 (1373 electors)

Composed of the regional county municipality of Maskinongé. Also composed of the municipalities of: Grandes-Piles, Hérouxville, Notre-Dame-du-Mont-Carmel, Saint-Roch-de-Mékinac, Saint-Tite and Shawinigan. Also includes the City of Trois-Rivières situated to the west of the Saint-Maurice River.

Ward #9 (420 electors)

Composed of the municipalities of: La Tuque, La Bostonnais, Lac Édouard and Trois-Rives. Also composed of the Native Reserves of: Coucoucache, Obedjiwan and Wemontaci. Also composed of the unorganized territories of: Lac-Blanc, Lac-Boulé, Lac-Croche, Lac-Lapeyrère, Lac-Masketsi, Lac-Normand, Linton and Rivière-de-la-Savanne.

Ward #10 (241 electors)

Composed of the regional county municipality of Jamésie. Also composed of the unorganized territories of: Lac Ashuapmushuan and Rivière Mistassini.

Ward #11 (1423 electors)

Composed of the regional county municipalities of: Lac-Saint-Jean-Est, Le Fjord-du-Saguenay, Le Domaine-du-Roy (excluding the unorganized territories of Lac Ashuapmushuan) and Maria-Chapdelaine (excluding the unorganized territory of Rivière Mistassini), Charlevoix and Charlevoix-Est. Also composed of the municipalities of: Saguenay. Also composed of the unorganized territory of Sagard.
