

Keep a minimum distance of 1 metre away from people at all times.

Wash your hands often with warm running water and soap for at least 20 secondes.

Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer if you do not have access to soap and water.

Pay close attention to the rules of hygiene when coughing or sneezing:

- Cover your mouth and nose with your arm to reduce the spread of germs.
- If you use a tissue, dispose of it as soon as possible and wash your hands immediately afterwards.

Avoid direct contact when greeting others, such as handshakes; please use alternative practices.

- Respect the isolation guildelines
- Inform your supervisor
- Avoid contact with those who are vulnerable, including the elderly and those with chronic illnesses.

For example, avoid visiting hospitalized people and those living in long-term care facilities or in the private residences.
