New Businessa) Adoption of Scenario: Policy on Remuneration and Constituency Expenses of the Council of Commissioners

WHEREAS three possible scenarios were elaborated as appendices to the policy;

b) RSEQ: Québec – Fees and Representatives

i) It was MOVED by E. Paradis, SECONDED by C. Lavallee and unanimously RESOLVED; THAT the Central Québec School Board pay membership fees of \$777.36 based on a per capita criterion per student population of the School Board, on the September 30th enrolment of the current school year. In so doing, the School Board acknowledges the objectives of the RSEQ-QCA and gives it the status of member, as set out in their letters patent.

ii) It was MOVED by E. Paradis, SECONDED by C. Lavallee and unanimously RESOLVED; THAT for the 2017-2018 school year the Central Québec School Board delegates Ms. Shelley Longney as the official delegate and Mr. Edward Sweeney as delegate to the Annual General Meeting. The School Board's representative's mandate is mainly in regard to the program of activities that the RSEQ-QCA has submitted to our attention. To this end, these delegates are officially mandated to participate in the decisions of the RSEQ-QCA and to follow-up on the decision making, in accordance with the procedures established by the School Board.

c) Association régionale du sport étudiant: Saguenay-Lac-St-Jean – Fees and Representative

Guay and unanimously RESOLVED; THAT the Central Québec School Board pay membership fees of \$150.00 based on a per capita criterion per student population of the School Board, on the September 30th enrolment of the current school year. In so doing, the School Board acknowledges the objectives of the Association and gives it the status of member, as set out in their letters patent.

WHEREAS GDUNO (*Gestion des données uniques des organismes*) has pointed out that the deeds of establishment for Riverside Regional School (elementary) and Riverside Regional School (secondary) are not clearly distinguishable and that this must be rectified;

WHEREAS the Governing Boards of each level have been consulted as stipulated in Section 79 of the Education Act;

It was MOVED by D. Ford-Caron, SECONDED by W. Marois and unanimously RESOLVED; THAT pursuant to section 211 of the Education Act, the Central Québec School Board Council of Commissioners adopt the revised names of Riverside Regional Elementary School / *École primaire régionale Riverside* and Riverside Regional High School / *École secondaire régionale Riverside* for the 2017-2018 school year as in **Appendix 2** to the minutes.

h) Annual Programming of Resources Pertaining to Informational Resources

WHEREAS the regular investments in informational resources are essential for the continuity of operations in terms of pedagogy as well as in administration;

WHEREAS the *Programmation annuelle en ressources informationnelles* (PARI) was established as a function of informational resources, notably in the area of maintenance and replacement of the School Board’s equipment;

WHEREAS the amounts projected by the PARI are determined as a function of the budgetary estimates available and take into consideration the commitments made by the School Board;

It was MOVED by S. Downs, SECONDED by C. Lavalée and unanimously RESOLVED; THAT the 2017-2018 annual programming of activities in Information Technology be adopted as deposited to *Collecte-info* by the Director General.

New Business (continued)i) Adherence to Supply Contracts Provided via *Collecto Services regroupés en éducation*

WHEREAS the Central Québec School Board (CQSB) reaps the benefits resulting from group purchasing processes such as those offered by the *Collecto Services regroupés en éducation*;

WHEREAS the CQSB must acquire Information Technology workstations, audiovisual equipment and interactive solutions in the next year;

WHEREAS measure 50760, *mise aux normes des infrastructures technologiques des commissions scolaires du Québec*, for the 2017-2018 school year specifies that purchases must be specifically carried out by participating in a group purchase;

WHEREAS the mandate pertaining to the provision of Information Technology workstations is of a one-year duration, with an option to renew for an additional year for a maximum of two years;

WHEREAS the mandate pertaining to the provision of audiovisual equipment and interactive solutions is of a 12-month duration, with an option to renew for two additional 12-month periods for a maximum of 36 months;

WHEREAS the Director General authorizes the contract attributed to one or several suppliers retained and for which the submitted cost does not exceed more than 10% of the lowest price (Art 18 Regulation on supply contracts of public bodies [C-65.1, r.2], so as to maximize Central Québec School Board's investments in training and management tools on the acquired equipment to the previous mandate;

It was MOVED by A. Visser, SECONDED by J. Rosenhek and unanimously RESOLVED; THAT the Central Québec School Board adhere to the Supply Contracts SAR130-2017 - *Postes informatiques et moniteurs neufs conforme aux règles budgétaires des commissions scolaires* and SAR150-2017 - *Équipements audiovisuels et solutions numériques interactives* from the *Collecto Services regroupés en éducation*; and

THAT the Director General be authorized to sign the mandate granted to the *Collecto Services regroupés en éducation* and any other document emanating from this resolution.
