#### 16-06.10 New Business

# c) Hiring of a General Contractor: St. Patrick's High School - washrooms

WHEREAS the Central Québec School Board had reserved part of the *maintien des bâtiments* budget for the renovation of the St. Patrick's High School washrooms;

WHEREAS plans and specifications were prepared and a public call for tenders for general contractors was published on SEAO (*Système électronique des appels d'offres du gouvernement du Québec*) on May 10, 2016 and the envelopes were opened on May 31, 2016;

WHEREAS the architect has recommended that the lowest tender be accepted as it met the requirements and specifications of the project;

It was MOVED by A. Visser, SECONDED by W. Marois and UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED; THAT the Central Québec School Board Council of Commissioners accept the lowest tender that met the specifications for the renovation of the St. Patrick's High School washrooms (75, rue Maisonneuve, Québec, QC G1R 2C4) as submitted by Louis Fecteau inc. (587, rue Adanac, Québec, QC G1C 7G6), in the amount of \$404,357.00 (taxes not included); and

THAT the Director General be authorized to sign the contracts on behalf of the School Board.

#### d) Janitorial Contract: MacLean Memorial School

WHEREAS a public call for tenders for janitorial services for MacLean Memorial School for the 2016-2017 to 2018-2019 school years was published on April 15, 2016 with tender documents to be submitted by May 9, 2016;

WHEREAS only one tender submitted contained the required documents and met the criteria established in the qualitative analysis, therefore the envelope containing the tender was opened;

WHEREAS it is recommended that the tender be accepted as it met the requirements and specifications;

It was MOVED by J.-A. Toulouse, SECONDED by W. Marois and UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED; THAT the Central Québec School Board award the contract for janitorial services for MacLean Memorial School (159, 5e Avenue, Chibougamau, QC G8P 2E6) for the 2016-2017 to 2018-2019 school years to Service d'entretien Servico (943, 3e Rue, Chibougamau, QC G8P 1R4) in the amount of \$221, 267.25 (taxes not included); and

THAT the Director General be authorized to sign the contract on behalf of the School Board.

# e) Janitorial Contract: Three Rivers Academy and Shawinigan High School

WHEREAS a public call for tenders for janitorial services for Three Rivers Academy and Shawinigan High School for the 2016-2017 to 2018-2019 school years was published on April 15, 2016 with tender documents to be submitted by May 9, 2016;

WHEREAS only one tender submitted contained the required documents and met the criteria established in the qualitative analysis, therefore the envelope containing the tender was opened;

WHEREAS it is recommended that the tender be accepted as it met the requirements and specifications;

It was MOVED by S. Downs, SECONDED by J.-A. Toulouse and UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED; THAT the Central Québec School Board award the contract for janitorial services for Three Rivers Academy (1875, rue Nicolas-Perrot, Trois-Rivières, QC G9A 1C5) and Shawinigan High School (1125, avenue des Cèdres, Shawinigan, QC G9N 1P7) for the 2016-2017 to 2018-2019 school years to Eureka (754, Notre-Dame Est, Thetford Mines, QC G6G 2S7) in the amount of \$357, 213.39 (taxes not included); and

THAT the Director General be authorized to sign the contract on behalf of the School Board.

Johnson Memorial School for the 2016-2017 to 2018-2019 school years was published on April 15, 2016 with tender documents to be submitted by May 9, 2016;

Rosenhek and UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED; THAT the Central Québec School Board award the contract for janitorial services for Everest Elementary School (2280, rue Laverdière, Québec, QC G1P 2T3), Portneuf Elementary School (35, rue Richard, Cap-Santé, QC G0A 1L0), St. Vincent School (995, rue Wolfe, Québec, QC G1V 3J9), Valcartier Elementary School (1748, boulevard Valcartier, St-Gabriel-de-Valcartier, QC G0A 4S0), Dollard-des-Ormeaux School (18, rue Ladas, Courcelette, QC G0A 1R1), St. Patrick's High School (75, rue Maisonneuve, Québec, QC G1R 2C4), Eastern Québec Learning Centre (3005, rue William Stuart, Québec, QC G1W 1V4) and A.S. Johnson Memorial School (919, rue Mooney Ouest, Thetford Mines, QC G6G 6H3)for the 2016-2017 to 2018-2019 school years to Derko (3020, rue Einstein, Québec, QC G1X 3X4) in the amount of \$1,688,970.15 (taxes not included); and

THAT the Director General be authorized to sign the contract on behalf of the School Board.

WHERAS the information contained in the authorization forms submitted by the Central Québec School Board to the Secretariat of the *Conseil du trésor* and published information on the electronic tendering system pursuant to the Act Respecting Contracting by Public Bodies (section C- 65.1) or the regulations, policies and directives made under this Act shall be the responsibility of the Central Québec School Board;

# g) Fiche de déclaration du dirigeant d'une organisme - 2015-2016 (continued)

WHEREAS the Central Québec School Board declaration certifies the reliability of data, information and explanations contained therein;

WHEREAS the Central Québec School Board has confirmed that there were no contracts above the \$100,000 public tender threshold that were awarded without going through the public tender process directly or through a purchasing group;

WHEREAS during this period, the Central Québec School Board maintained information and measures of reliable agreement with the compliance systems in contract management, the Act Respecting Contracting by Public Bodies as well as regulations, policies and guidelines made under this Act;

WHEREAS the Central Québec School Board declares that all required information has been forwarded to the Secretariat of the *Conseil du trésor*, pursuant to the Directive on accountability in contract management of public agencies and that it and the information published on the electronic tendering system to tender for the period from April 1st, 2015 to March 31st, 2016 are reliable;
