d) Update from Financial Services

The need for a new auditor has been brought up, but the restriction to have them be bilingual makes it harder to find the right firm. However, as per the Chairman's recommendation, language should not be a reason to refuse any candidate, especially considering the current lack of tenders and since most employees dealing with the auditors can speak French. Commissioner Kilganan wondered if this would incur any changes in the presentation of documents, but the Chairman reassured the council that no extra work will be required since the documents are already sent to the MEQ in French. The only translations would occur during correspondences or meetings.

e) Update from Secretariat General

The Secretary General has initiated contact with a lawyer from Québec with the goal of creating a foundation for the CQSB. This entity would allow the school board to receive funds from other foundations and give receipts to the donors. Further updates will follow when the entity is created.

a) Three-year Plan & Deeds of Establishment (adoption)

WHEREAS section 211 also stipulates that, in accordance with the plan, deeds of establishment are to be issued to each school and centre listed in the plan;

It was MOVED by C. Lavallee, SECONDED by A. Gosselin, and unanimously RESOLVED; THAT pursuant to section 211 of the Education Act, the Central Québec School Board adopt the three-year plan and the deeds of establishment for its schools and centres for the 2024-2025, 2025-2026, 2026-2027 school years as presented.

Pigeon, did a report on the RAC Meeting: close to half a million dollars were received for the *Plan de rattrapage* and since the law requires to share such financial assistance from the government, a meeting of all director generals from the nine English school boards was held last week.

24-01.15 Quebec English School Boards Association

a) Report from the Board of Directors

There has been no new meeting since December, but the next one will discuss the issue that most rules are not adapted to school boards, as they are meant for the *centre de services scolaires*. QESBA will have a meeting with the Minister on February 6th and plans to present the realities faced by the nine English school boards.

b) Commissioners

Commissioner J. Greene asked for some help from the council to raise funds for a new playground at the Riverside Regional schools. The Chairman answered that, unfortunately, the school board will not participate in this campaign as the budget is towards maintenance, rather than new investments. There is a process where you can match funds with the *Ministère de l'Éducation* and it has been done throughout the past decade.

Similarly, Commissioner D. Ford-Caron asked when and where the school board planned to reinstate the playground that had been removed during the Riverside Regional Elementary School expansion. B. Sévigny, Director of Buildings and Equipment, answered that a part of the budget is allocated to the replacement of moved elements and courtyard repairs. Drafts of the new playground will be presented to the council as soon as they are available.

Commissioner D. Ford-Caron reminded the members that up until February 1st, 5 p.m., applications for the governor general's medal can still be submitted. There is no limit to the number of applications sent from the same school. The Chairman reassured the council that all principals have been informed. Should any students from CQSB be selected, the commissioner from that ward will be asked to represent the school board.
