

Electronics & Valuables:

Valcartier Elementary School adheres to the CQSB's **CODE OF ETHICS GOVERNING THE USE OF INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY RESOURCES** this also would include cyber bullying as defined by law (refer to VES' Anti-bullying policy).

As an addendum to this code of ethics, students having recreational devices such as smart phones, cell phones, and other electronic items must keep them in their schoolbags. School personnel and bus drivers will not be held responsible if the items are lost, damaged or stolen on the bus.

Students can use their personal devices, such as laptops and tablets, in class for academic purposes. A written consent from parents must be signed prior to use.

However, the school personnel will not be held responsible if the items are lost, damaged or stolen at school.

Parental Consent – Use of Personal Devices at VES I allow my child to bring to school and use our home device. I agree to the conditions set out in this policy. Parent signature : Home device (Model & serial number) :

It is recommended that anything of personal or monetary value to your child should be kept at home. All installments in cash sent to school must be sent in an identified sealed envelope. A receipt will be issued for cash payments.

VES Dress Code

Clothes must not expose under garments or expose too much of the anatomy.

For example, plunging neckline, short sweaters that show midriff, shorts or short skirts/dresses that are TOO short (an arm's length being the unit of measurement) will not be tolerated.

Clothes must not carry inappropriate images/slogans, etc.

If it is determined that the student's clothes do not meet the dress code regulations, the student will be warned, and will be provided a school T-shirt to wear over. Parents may be called to bring appropriate clothing to school if necessary. Parents must wash and return the school T-shirt the following day.
