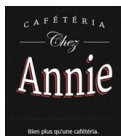

If your child forgets their lunch at home, please contact our cafeteria service directly!



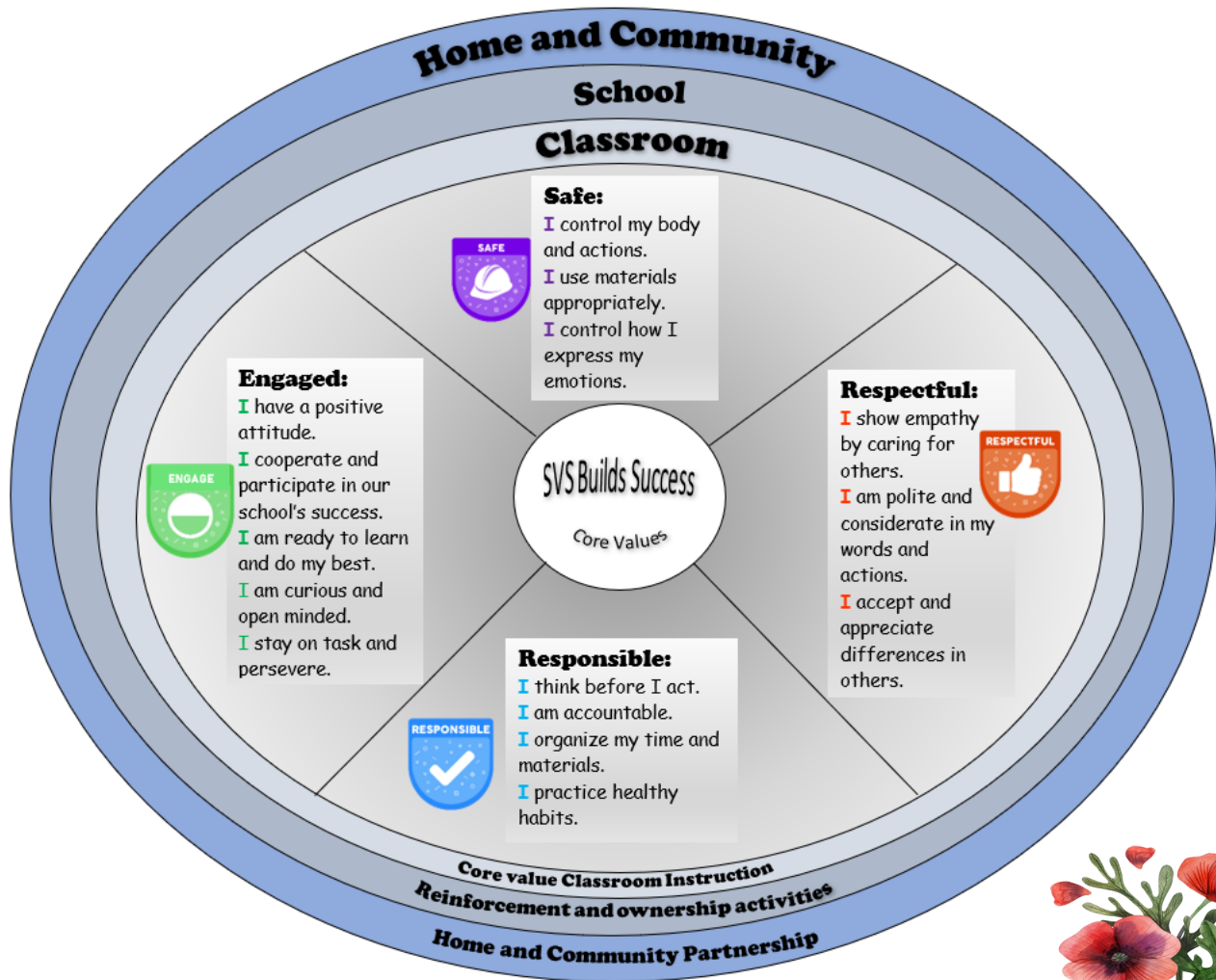
