



## Supplies required for the 2018-2019 school year-CYCLE 2

*It isn't important or necessary to purchase new supplies; parents are encouraged to use items children already have.*

### PLEASE IDENTIFY ALL SCHOOL SUPPLIES AND CLOTHING.

#### HOMEROOM

- 1 Pencil case\* (to hold all classroom materials)
- 1 pack **yellow** construction paper **Grade 3 students**
- 1 pack **blue** construction paper **Grade 4 students**
- 24 lead pencils HB (all sharpened, identified) **no mechanical pencils please; will ask for more as the year progresses** (Mirado/Sanford)
- 1 pair scissors (good quality)
- 1 30-cm ruler (wood or metal)
- 4 highlighters (2 yellow, 2 orange)
- 3 white erasers (Staedtler); will ask for more as year progresses
- 2 large (40 gram) glue sticks (Lepage or Pritt)
- 1 bottle of liquid white glue **Grade 3 students**
- 1 set of coloured pencils (sharpened)
- 1 set of markers (recommend Crayola washables)
- 4 dry-erase markers and 1 old sock/cloth (2 thin markers – 2 thick markers) (Not Dollarama)
- 1 black fine point Sharpie marker, **identified**
- 1 black ultra fine Sharpie permanent marker, **identified**
- 2 Pens (1 blue, 1 red)
- 12 duo tangs (**with pockets and fasteners – 2 each** green, red, blue, black, yellow & orange)
- 1 2-inch binder with a clear plastic sleeve/pocket in front for portfolio (available from Bureau en Gros. **Grade 3 students or new Grade 4 students** (*Grade 4 students will use last year's binder*))
- 100 vinyl sheet protectors (**Already inserted in the 2-inch portfolio binder**), can use last year's; please empty first
- 1 **1 1/2-inch binder with pockets in front and back; sturdy (will be used daily, can be last year's)**
- 8 lined exercise books (8.5x11 - 3-hole punch - Hilroy, Canadian)
- 1 package of 200 lined sheets (loose leaf)
- 1 set of headphones
- 1 pencil sharpener (Staedtler), **identified**
- 3 boxes Kleenex tissues (*for reasons of personal hygiene, it is recommended to provide your child with a box of tissue paper that can be renewed as needed*). Will ask for more when required

#### Optional, but gratefully accepted

- 1 sturdy waterproof school bag – large enough to carry a 2-inch binder
- 1 spiral sketch book (dollar store will do)

*\*an existing container or carry-all from home will do: should be sturdy enough to last the year.*

### **A change of clothes from home for gym are required**

(Students in Grades 3 to 6 are required to change their clothes for Physical Education classes and should not expect to wear their gym clothes in the classroom. Shorts, leggings, sweatpants and a t-shirt or a polo shirt (in a cloth bag) are acceptable for gym classes. T-shirts or polo shirts should cover undergarments. Skateboard shoes or high-heeled platform running shoes are not appropriate for gym. Flat shoe laces stay tied better than round ones.)

**Students must have a clean pair of indoor shoes to wear at all times in the building. These could be their gym shoes.**
