You'll need your child's ID number and the email you provided us to register.

Your email is the link to our system. Therefore make sure it's accurate. If you change your email address make sure you inform the DDO office as soon as possible at <u>ddo@cqsb.qc.ca</u>.

We highly recommend you use your personal email address and not a work address, especially for our military parents.

TRANSPORTATION

To make a change to your **transportation stop** (bus stop location or adding a 2nd address) you need to contact the Transportation Department at the School Board. Changes can take between 48 and 72 hours to go into effect and some bus routes currently have wait lists, so plan accordingly.

To inform us of a **change of home address** please contact the school directly at <u>ddo@cqsb.qc.ca</u> and we will inform the Transportation Department. This information must be received **at least one week prior to your move** to allow for changes to be confirmed.

DAYCARE

It is **important** that students dress according to the weather every day since all daycare students will enjoy the outdoors from 7:10 to 8:15 and 15:15 to 16:30, or as early as 14:30 for **Kindergarten** students.

Parents can no longer request that their child in Elementary be sent to Daycare directly after dismissal at 15:15. Your child will be called when you arrive at the puzzle door via the Kouloo App, and will meet you there.

Early Dismissals

Parents must report to the front door, ring and we will respond as quickly as possible. As of 2:50 p.m., your child will follow their usual dismissal routine. No early dismissals can be accepted as students are in transition or getting ready to leave.

For safety reasons, after school all daycare students will go through the glassed Multi Function Room (Puzzle Door) and meet their parents until 4:30 p.m. After 4:30 p.m. parents must meet their children at daycare. **Parents are not allowed in school. They must use the Daycare doorbell to ask for their child.**

LUNCH PERIOD



During lunch only those students walking home for lunch are allowed off school grounds. Secondary students can leave school grounds without parental consent, but are expected back in time for afternoon classes. If returning late they must report to the front office where they will be given a late slip to

return to class. Please note that parents are responsible for their children when they are off school grounds during school hours. Walkers are allowed to return to school **5 minutes before the end of lunch** (Elementary Grades 4 to 6: 12:05 / Kindergarten: 12:10 / Secondary : 12:30 / Elementary Grades 1 to 3: 13:05)

Parents are reminded that there are no microwave ovens for Kindergarten and Elementary students. Students must bring a cold lunch or use a thermos. Secondary students have access to a microwave in the student lounge.

Misbehaviour Pyramid of Interventions

We encourage parents to remind their children of the importance of playing safely and respecting everyone's personal space.

Guidelines students must respect from the Hands-off Policy:

- No student is to touch another student in a manner judged inappropriate by staff.
- * No student uses any form of physical restraint against other students, even in "fun" or as a "practical joke."
- Roughhousing and play-fighting will not be tolerated.

Based on age, students can redeem themselves after a determined time. Homeroom teachers will inform parents when students have behaved well.

Implemented

DDO staff included disrespectful slurs and verbal aggressions in the Pyramid of Interventions.

Students and parents will get more information from the school team and you will be asked to sign the Common Expectations sheet. We are convinced that respectful language will significantly impact our students' overall growth.
